

RESOLUTION 2019-17

A RESOLUTION AWARDING THE CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT (COF CONTRACT NO. 2018-0252) FOR THE JIM WARREN CITY PARK TENNIS COURT REPAIR PROJECT TO TENNESSEE VALLEY PAVING CO., INC., IN THE AMOUNT OF \$779,321.00.

WHEREAS, on February 21, 2019, sealed bids were received, publicly opened, and read aloud by the Engineering Department for the Jim Warren City Park Tennis Court Repair Project; and

WHEREAS, after thorough review of the submitted bids, City staff recommends award of this construction contract to Tennessee Valley Paving Co., Inc., in the amount of \$779,321.00; and

WHEREAS, in case of any unforeseen or changed project conditions, quantities, or cost overruns, City staff requests an additional \$75,000.00 project contingency to allow for the expedient completion of the Jim Warren City Park Tennis Court Repair Project.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF FRANKLIN, TENNESSEE, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I. Approval is granted to award the construction contract (COF Contract No. 2018-0252) to Tennessee Valley Paving Co., Inc., in the amount of \$779,321.00, and authority is granted to the City Administrator to finalize and sign COF Contract No. 2018-0252 for the Jim Warren City Park Tennis Court Repair Project.

SECTION II. Approval is granted to create a project contingency in the amount of \$75,000.00 for the Project, and authority is granted to the City Administrator, City Engineer, and the Assistant Director of Engineering to review and approve the spending of all project funds, both in the bid award and for the project contingency, toward the completion of the Jim Warren City Park Tennis Court Repair Project.
