A RESOLUTION TO APPROVE AN ALIGNMENT STUDY FOR CARLISLE LANE AND DEL RIO PIKE

WHEREAS, the Board of Mayor and Aldermen (BOMA) of the City of Franklin, Tennessee adopted the 2010 Major Thoroughfare Plan on September 23, 2010; and

WHEREAS, the 2010 Major Thoroughfare Plan establishes recommendations for roadway improvements, recommends a priority ranking for their implementation, and established roadway classifications; and

WHEREAS, the 2010 Major Thoroughfare Plan project number 66 recommends improvements on Carlisle Lane to Del Rio Pike as a long term priority; and

WHEREAS, the BOMA desires to approve an alignment study for Carlisle Lane and Del Rio Pike as shown on Attachment A; and

WHEREAS, a public meeting was held on April 9, 2015 to obtain public input from all impacted property owners; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF FRANKLIN, TENNESSEE, that alignment Option D, as shown on Attachment A, be approved with future consideration for a roundabout at the intersection of Carlisle Lane and Del Rio Pike.
