# **Operational Summary**

- Connected to the Marriott Hotel; built in 1999; last major renovation in August of 2015.
- 297 guest rooms; 3 suites
- 29,000 square feet of flexible meeting space including ballroom space for up to 1,100 guests
- 2017 / 2018 producing forecasted 199,935 covers (guests) with a combined average check of \$22.07
- Occupancy: 949 events, 4,151 functions
- Overall healthy environment in the area. Definite business pacing +6% (+\$149K) over same time last year. Price increases driving this revenue increase.
- Group convention business is a key contributor towards revenue in the conference center. Group room nights are pacing flat year over year.
- There is currently a positive environment for Assoc. and short term corporate group. New supply could have significant impact on this.



# Organizational Structure / Relation to City

- Hotel and Conference Center managed by Davidson Hotels and Resorts.
- Management of the facility began in July, 2014.
- Hotel is owned by Crow Holdings in Dallas, TX.
- Conference Center and Hotel Revenues are not shared.
- Most expenses are shared between the hotel and conference center.
  - Admin and General & Engineering: Split as a percentage of total revenue
  - Sales: 50-50 Split
  - Catering and Event Management: 100% conference center
  - Food and Beverage: expenses split as a percentage of food revenue

#### 3 Year Financial Summary

• 2016 / 2017 Actual:

• Revenue: \$6.9M

• Net Profit: \$534K

• 2017 / 2018 Projected:

Revenue: \$7.4M (+\$426K to current budget)

Net Profit: \$752K (+\$342K to current budget)

• 2018 / 2019 Budget:

• Revenue: \$7.6M

Net Profit: \$805K



# Financial & Budget Overview: p.2

#### **Items Impacting Current FY Revenue Budget**

- No new revenue generators entering market and supply is increasing.
- Based on current pace, we anticipate slight growth due to annual price increases.
- With projected occupancy percentage, we have reached maximum capacity for group business.
- Additional hotel supply due to come online not only in the Franklin / Cool Springs area but Nashville as well (15 hotels with over 3,000 guest rooms anticipated in 2018).
- Renaissance Hotel in Nashville under major meeting space renovation in 2017 / 2018.
   Compression of group business was seen this year but will not repeat next year.
- Additional free standing event venues in Franklin / Williamson & Rutherford Co.
   continue to take local social events.



# Financial & Budget Overview: p.3

#### **Items Impacting Current FY Expense Budget**

- Info & Telecom Expense (-\$21K): CI/TY (Marriott Sales System) fees decreased in 2018.
- A&G Payroll (+\$34K): General Manager Position open for 4 mos. in 2017 / 2018. GM bonus was forfeited due to timing of resignation.
- Available labor continues to be a struggle. The additional supply that has and will
  be coming online has limited available personnel and continues to drive wages
  higher due to demand and overtime as well as a heavy reliance on contract labor.
- Management Bonus (-\$41K): Anticipated reduction in paid management bonus.
