# 1. Approval of Minutes

Alderman Petersen moved to approve the January 27, 2015 Work Session and January 27, 2015 Board of Mayor and Aldermen minutes as presented. Seconded by Vice Mayor Barnhill. Motion carried unanimously.

#### 2. Proclamation Procurement Month

Mayor Moore proclaimed the month of March 2015 as Procurement Month for the City of Franklin, Tennessee. City Administrator Eric Stuckey accepted the Proclamation on behalf of the Purchasing Department.

3. Proclamation Congenital Heart Defect Awareness Week

Local families affected by congenital heart disease came forward while Dr. Moore read the Proclamation for Congenital Heart Defect Awareness Week. Ashley Daniel accepted the Proclamation and thanked the Mayor and everyone on behalf of the group.

4. Proclamation 4<sup>th</sup> Battalion, 5<sup>th</sup> Special Forces Group (Airborne)

Former Mayor Tom Miller, his wife Lydia Miller, and Mike Alexander came forward with the soldiers and their spouses, for the reading of the Proclamation to adopt and offer on-going respect and moral support to the 4<sup>th</sup> Battalion, 5<sup>th</sup> Special Forces Group (Airborne).

The Executive Officer thanked the City on behalf of the soldiers and their families. He said this is the first time a Green Beret unit has been adopted by a city for outreach for soldiers and their families.
