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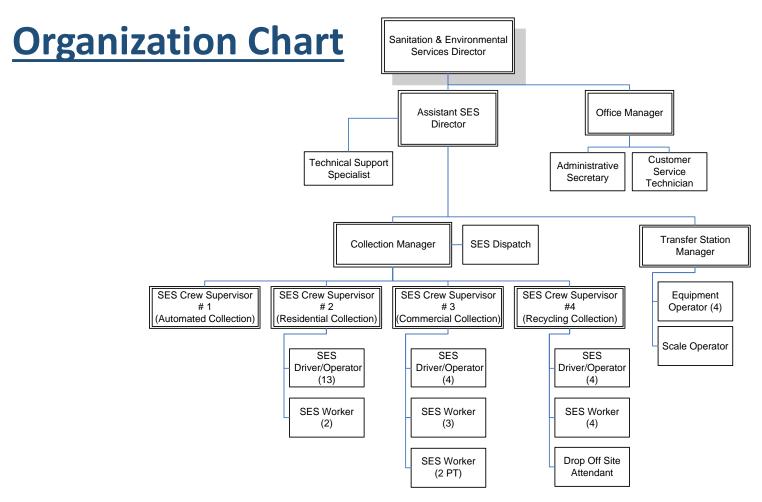


Purpose of Department

Base Budget Request: Personnel

Personnel:

2016: \$2,912,851

2017: \$3,130,657

Difference: \$217,806 or 7.5%

Reason: Increases in medical premiums, pension assessments and starting wage calculations for open positions.



Base Budget Request: Operations

Operations:

2016: \$4,928,783

2017: \$6,148,173

Difference: \$1,221,390 or 24.8%

Reason: Sharply increased tonnage crossing the transfer station scales in FY 2016 as well as much higher repair and maintenance needs for the facility.
