


Mission of the Franklin Parks Department

Base Budget Request: Operations

FY 17 Operations: \$1,762,140, or a decrease of 44.9% (\$1,473,329) from FY 16 budget (budget inflated due to grants received during the year for battlefield acquisitions)

Increases due to new property: ~Harlinsdale Arena ~Carter's Hill Battlefield Park ~Increase in freight & contracts ~Increase in number of patrons attending events (special & athletics)
