ORDINANCE 2016-39

TO BE ENTITLED: "AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTERS 3 AND 5 OF THE ZONING ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF FRANKLIN, TENNESSEE, TO ADOPT THE NEW FEMA FLOOD INSURANCE RATE MAPS, AND AMEND THE CITY OF FRANKLIN ZONING MAP TO UPDATE THE BOUNDARIES OF THE FLOODWAY FRINGE (FFO) AND FLOODWAY (FWO) OVERLAY DISTRICTS ACCORDINGLY."

WHEREAS, the City of Franklin, Tennessee, is a participant in the National Flood Insurance Program (NFIP); and

WHEREAS, the NFIP and Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) requires local communities to maintain certain requirements; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Mayor and Aldermen (BOMA) wishes to maintain eligibility in the NFIP, and in order to do so must meet the NFIP regulations found in Title 44 of the Code of Federal Regulations (CFR), Ch. 1, § 60.3; and

WHEREAS, areas of the City of Franklin are subject to periodic inundation which could result in loss of life and property, health and safety hazards, disruption of commerce and governmental services, extraordinary public expenditures for flood protection and relief, and impairment of the tax base, all of which adversely affect the public health, safety and general welfare; and

WHEREAS, flood losses are caused by the cumulative effect of obstructions in floodplains, resulting in increases in flood heights and velocities; by uses in flood hazard areas which are vulnerable to floods; or construction which is inadequately elevated, floodproofed, or otherwise unprotected from flood damages; and

WHEREAS, the Legislature of the State of Tennessee has in *Tennessee Code Annotated* (T.C.A.) §§ 13-7-201 through 13-7-210, delegated the responsibility to local government units to adopt municipal zoning regulations designed to promote the public health, safety, and general welfare of its citizenry; and

WHEREAS, the City of Franklin has previously adopted the FWO – Floodway Overlay District (FWO) and FFO – Floodway Fringe Overlay District (FFO); and

WHEREAS, the BOMA wishes to amend Subsections 3.4.4 and 3.4.5 in order to update the references to the FEMA Flood Insurance Study (FIS) and Flood Insurance Rate Map (FIRM) adopted in Subsection 5.8.5 (2) (b) that form the basis for the location of the FWO and FFO Overlay Districts; and

WHEREAS, the City of Franklin has previously adopted Floodplain Protection standards in Chapter 5, Subsection 5.8.5, of the City of Franklin Zoning Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the BOMA wishes to amend Subsection 5.8.5 (2) (b) of the Franklin Zoning Ordinance in order to update the list of Flood Insurance Rate Map, Community Panel Numbers, in order to include and formally adopt the new Flood Insurance Rate Maps, dated December 22, 2016; and

WHEREAS, FEMA formally notified the City of Franklin and issued a final Flood Hazard Determination (FHD) on June 22, 2016; and

WHEREAS, the City of Franklin is required to adopt the new FIS and FIRMs within six (6) months from the date of the FHD; and

WHEREAS, upon passage of Ordinance 2016-39, the City of Franklin is authorized by the CFR to begin utilizing and enforcing the data contained in the new FIS and FIRMs prior to the December 22, 2016, effective date; and

WHEREAS, the BOMA wishes to amend the City of Franklin Zoning Map, to update the boundaries of the FWO and FFO Overlay Districts to coincide with the new FIS and FIRMs; and

WHEREAS, these amendments are in the best interest of the citizens of Franklin.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF FRANKLIN, TENNESSEE, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I. That Chapter 3, Subsection 3.4.4 (4) of the Franklin Zoning Ordinance is hereby amended to delete the following text noted with a strikethrough; to add the following text noted in **bold**, and is approved to read as follows:

(4) Undesignated Tributaries and Drainage Areas Within or Affecting the City
The FWO District shall coincide with floodways designated in the Flood Insurance Studyies or
and on the National Flood Insurance Program Flood Insurance Rate Maps, hereinafter referred
to as FIRMs, effective September 29, 2006 adopted in Subsection 5.8.5 (2) (b), or as
subsequently amended by either a Letter of Map Amendment or a Letter of Map Revision. The
FWO District width for tributaries and drainage areas within or affecting the city that do not
have designated floodways depicted on the zoning map or are not delimited in the Flood
Insurance Studies or FIRMs shall be established in accordance with the stormwater
management ordinance.

SECTION II. That Chapter 3, Subsection 3.4.5 (5) of the Franklin Zoning Ordinance is hereby amended to delete the following text noted with a strikethrough; to add the following text noted in **bold**, and is approved to read as follows:

(5) Undesignated Tributaries and Drainage Areas Within or Affecting the City
The FFO District shall coincide with the 100-year floodplain or floodway fringe boundary as
designated in the Flood Insurance Studyies or on the FIRMs, effective September 29, 2006
adopted in Subsection 5.8.5 (2) (b), or as subsequently amended by either a Letter of Map
Amendment or a Letter of Map Revision. The FFO District width for tributaries and drainage
areas within or affecting the city that do not have designated floodway fringe areas depicted on
the zoning map or are not delimited in the Flood Insurance Studies or FIRMs shall be established
in accordance with the stormwater management ordinance.

SECTION III. That Chapter 5, Subsection 5.8.5 (2) (b) of the Franklin Zoning Ordinance is hereby amended to delete the following text noted with a strikethrough; to add the following text noted in **bold**, and is approved to read as follows:

- (b) Basis for Establishing the Areas of Special Flood Hazard

 The Areas of Special Flood Hazard identified in the City of Franklin, Tennessee, as identified by

 FEMA, and in its Flood Insurance Study (FIS) and Flood Insurance Rate Map (FIRM), Community

 Panel Numbers 47187C0180F; 47187C0182F; 47187C0184F; 47187C0190F; 47187C0192F;

 47187C0195F; 47187C0203F; 47187C0204F; 47187C0205F; 47187C0208F; 47187C0209F;

 47187C0211F; 47187C0212F; 47187C0213F; 47187C0214F; 47187C0220F; 47187C0230F;

 47187C0335F; 47187C0355F; 47187C0360F; dated, September 29, 2006, along with all supporting technical data, are adopted by reference and declared to be a part of Section 5.8.5.
 - (i) The Areas of Special Flood Hazard in the City of Franklin, Tennessee, are identified by FEMA in its Flood Insurance Study (FIS) dated December 22, 2016, and on the Flood Insurance Rate Map (FIRM), Community 470206, as follows:

 - (ii) The FIS and FIRMs, along with all supporting technical data, are hereby adopted by reference and declared to be a part of Subsection 5.8.5.

SECTION IV. That the Franklin Zoning Map shall be, and is hereby, amended to revise the boundaries of the FWO – Floodway Overlay District (FWO) and FFO – Floodway Fringe Overlay District (FFO) to coincide with the Flood Insurance Study (FIS) and Flood Insurance Rate Maps as specified in the Franklin Zoning Ordinance, Chapter 3, Subsections 3.4.4 (4), 3.4.5 (5), and as adopted and further described in Chapter 5, Subsection 5.8.5 (2) (b).

SECTION V. BE IT FINALLY ORDAINED by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Franklin, Tennessee, that this Ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage on third and final reading, the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens requiring it.
