RESOLUTION 2015-104

A RESOLUTION OF INTENT TO FUND AND AUTHORIZE THE CITY'S PORTION OF THE WILLIAMSON COUNTY WIDE RADIO SYSTEM PROJECT

WHEREAS, the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Franklin, Tennessee, desires to facilitate the improvement of existing emergency communication technologies used by the City of Franklin; and

WHEREAS, the City has joined the City of Brentwood and the County of Williamson to effect a regional system that is superior to the existing system; and

WHEREAS, the City has agreed in an Interlocal Agreement to provide funding for its share of the cost of the system improvements ("System Improvements"); and

WHEREAS, the Board of Mayor and Aldermen resolved on July 14, 2015, by Resolution 2015-36, to authorize the City Administrator to make application to the Tennessee Municipal Bond Fund for the City's portion of the cost of Phase I of the System Improvements in an amount not to exceed \$2.6 million; and

WHEREAS, the anticipated full cost (all phases) of the System Improvements for which the City of Franklin is responsible have been determined in a project proposal; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Mayor and Aldermen desires to express its intent to fund the City's portion of the cost of the System Improvements and to approve moving forward with the Countywide Radio system project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen for the City of Franklin as follows:

- Section 1. The City Administrator and staff shall make application to the Tennessee Municipal Bond Fund for funding approval for the System Improvements, raising the total applied-for funds to a maximum of \$4.0 million.
- Section 2. The Board of Mayor and Aldermen hereby expresses its intent to fund the City's portion of the System Improvements and to authorize the staff to move forward with implementation of the County-wide radio project.
- **Section 3.** This Resolution shall be effective upon adoption.
