

**RESOLUTION 2016-04**

**TO BE ENTITLED, “A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE SECOND YEAR, 2016 THROUGH 2017 ANNUAL ACTION PLAN FOR CDBG FUNDING FOR THE CITY OF FRANKLIN, TENNESSEE.”**

**WHEREAS**, as part of the City of Franklin’s agreement to be an Entitlement City the Housing and Urban Development (HUD) Office requires the City complete an Annual Action Plan regarding the disbursement of grant funds that are awarded to the City of Franklin; and

**WHEREAS**, the Annual Action Plan reflects the conditions under which the City has met the requirements of the plan and reflects how the City shall disburse the Community Development Block Grant funds for the fiscal year 2016-2017; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Mayor and Aldermen believes it is in the best interest of the City of Franklin to identify these conditions and the policies and procedures that govern the Community Development Building Grant awards; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Mayor and Aldermen believes it is in the best interest of the City of Franklin to adopt the Annual Action Plan in order to meet the Congressional Intent that requires Entitlement City grantees to expend their funds in a manner that effectively meets local needs but primarily serves low-income residents.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF FRANKLIN, TENNESSEE, AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. The 2016-2017 Annual Action Plan, attached as Exhibits A hereto, are adopted.

Section 2. The Housing Development Coordinator of the City shall be responsible for the administration and enforcement of the Annual Action Plan and the Five Year Consolidated Plan hereby adopted.

Section 3. Changes or revisions to the Plans hereby adopted shall be made only by resolution of the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Franklin.
