

RESOLUTION 2019-97

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE USE OF THE COMPETITIVE SEALED PROPOSAL PROCUREMENT METHOD FOR CHOOSING SUPPLIERS AND SERVICE PROVIDERS FOR (1) POLICE PROMOTIONAL PROCESS ASSESSMENT SERVICES, (2) LIABILITY, PROPERTY AND WORKERS' COMPENSATION INSURANCE PRODUCTS AND SERVICES, AND (3) NEAR-SITE CLINIC HEALTHCARE SERVICES

WHEREAS, pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. § 12-3-1207 the City may use competitive sealed proposals rather than competitive sealed bids when the City adopts a process for the use of competitive sealed proposals and determines that the use of competitive sealed bidding is either not practicable or not advantageous to the City; and

WHEREAS, the City passed Ordinance 2019-24 on August 13, 2019, authorizing the use of the competitive sealed proposal procurement method; and

WHEREAS, should the City choose to pursue conducting its own competitive process for establishing the basis of pricing pursuant to sealed submittals and published legal notice, then City staff requests authority to use the competitive sealed proposal procurement method for determining which suppliers and service providers to recommend for award of (1) police promotional process assessment services, (2) liability, property and workers' compensation insurance products and services, and (3) near-site clinic healthcare services; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Mayor and Aldermen find that the use of the competitive sealed proposal procurement method is advantageous to the City because qualifications, experience, and competence are more important than price in making the purchases and because there is more than one solution to the purchases and the competitive sealed proposal procurement method will assist in choosing the best solution and supplier and/or service provider.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF FRANKLIN, TENNESSEE, AS FOLLOWS:

Should the City choose to pursue conducting its own competitive process for establishing the basis of pricing pursuant to sealed submittals and published legal notice, then the City is authorized to use the competitive sealed proposal procurement method pursuant to the standards set forth in Municipal Code § 5-504 for determining which suppliers and service providers to recommend for award of (1) police promotional process assessment services, (2) liability, property and workers' compensation insurance products and services, and (3) near-site clinic healthcare services because qualifications, experience, and competence are more important than price in making the purchases and because there is more than one solution to the purchases and the competitive sealed proposal procurement method will assist in choosing the best solution and supplier and/or service provider.
