

ORDINANCE 2017-09

TO BE ENTITLED: "AN ORDINANCE TO REPLACE THE FRANKLIN TRANSPORTATION & STREET TECHNICAL STANDARDS, AS ADOPTED BY REFERENCE IN TITLE 16, CHAPTER 11 OF THE FRANKLIN MUNICIPAL CODE"

WHEREAS, the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Franklin, Tennessee, on May 10, 2011, adopted Ordinance 2011-13, Franklin Transportation & Street Technical Standards, to provide uniform engineering and technical standards for transportation-related design and construction projects within the City; and

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has recognized the need to revise the Standards to better reflect the intent of what the City desires as to completed transportation and street projects as well as to correct typographical errors or incomplete information concerning some of the Standards.

NOW THEREFORE:

SECTION I: BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF FRANKLIN, Tennessee, that Section. 16-1101 (1), of Chapter 11, of Title 16 shall be deleted in its entirety and the following substituted in lieu thereof:

“(1) Purpose. In order to provide better streets throughout the city, reflecting best practices and providing more capacity with safe and comfortable travel for motorists, pedestrians, bicyclists, and transit riders, the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Franklin have adopted the “City of Franklin Transportation & Street Technical Standards, 2017 Edition” (“Street Specifications”). The adoption of these uniform standards will encourage consistency and quality in street design and construction to meet the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of Franklin and the traveling public.”

SECTION II: BE IT FINALLY ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF FRANKLIN, Tennessee, that this Ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage on second and final reading, the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of Franklin requiring it.
