


Purpose of Department

Base Budget Request: Personnel

Personnel

2016: \$11,445,851

2016: \$11,915,615

Difference: \$ 469,764 (or 4.1%)

Increase due to higher forecast medical care premiums, higher pension costs and slightly higher forecast overtime. Overall regular wages are dropping year over year as a result of retirements.



Base Budget Request: Operations

Operations

2016: \$ 2,972,240

2017: \$ 2,945,681

Difference: (\$ 26,559) or (0.9%)

Decrease due to significantly lower estimate fuel costs and reduction in lease payments.



Program Enhancement Requests

11 requests, totaling \$2,014,442

Requests can be grouped into three categories:

- -Vehicles and Vehicle Maintenance (Priorities 1, 2 & 3)
- -Personnel (Priorities 5 & 7)
- -Equipment and Operations (Priorities 4, 6, 8, 9, 10 & 11)
