ORDINANCE 2018-42

AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH A NO PARKING ZONE ON SOUTH MARGIN STREET AND TO IMPLEMENT A PAVEMENT MARKING AND SIGNAGE PLAN.

WHEREAS, the sight distance from 2nd Avenue South onto South Margin Street does not meet the minimum requirements as published in both the City of Franklin's *Transportation & Street Technical Standards, 2017 Edition* ("Franklin Street Specs") and the American Association of State Highway and Transportation Officials' *A Policy on Geometric Design of Highways and Streets, 6th Edition, 2011* ("Green Book"); and

WHEREAS, due to limited sight distance, staff recommends that on-street parking be prohibited as shown on Exhibit A.

NOW THEREFORE:

IT IC CO OPPAINTD AND DONE on this the

SECTION I: BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Franklin, Tennessee, that parking shall be prohibited on South Margin Street as shown in Exhibit A.

SECTION II: BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the Director of Streets is hereby authorized and directed to implement the pavement marking and signage plan as shown in Exhibit A.

SECTION III: BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Franklin, Tennessee, that the penalty for failure to obey the provisions of this Ordinance shall be as indicated in the Franklin Municipal Code and/or the Tennessee Code Annotated.


