Dear Mr. Parker:

The current agreement between the City of Franklin and the U.S. Geological Survey for continuation of the operation of gaging stations expires on September 30, 2015. Enclosed for renewal are two copies of the Joint Funding Agreement for continuation of this project for the period of October 1, 2015 to September 30, 2016. The total cost for operating the gaging stations during this period will be \$57,250.00 with the City of Franklin's share being \$33,800.00. The USGS will contribute \$8,450 in Federal matching towards this effort and National Streamflow Information Program funds will total \$15,000.00.

This agreement will be operated on a fixed price basis and will be billed quarterly. The results of work under this agreement will be available for publication by the U.S. Geological Survey. Upon acceptance, please return one copy of the Joint Funding Agreement to this office addressed to the attention of Vicky Brantley, keeping one copy for your records.

We appreciate your cooperation in this program and look forward to a continuation of our relationship with the City of Franklin.
