

RESOLUTION 2017-84

A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE PREPARATION FOR INSTALLATION OF A TEMPORARY 5' WIDE SIDEWALK FROM NORTH OF CLAUDE YATES DRIVE TO NORTH OF MACK HATCHER PARKWAY, TO BE FUNDED BY A FUTURE BUDGET AMENDMENT

WHEREAS, following the completion of the Hillsboro Road Improvements Project there will be a 1,100-foot-long sidewalk gap on the east side of Hillsboro Road from north of Claude Yates Drive to North of Mack Hatcher Parkway; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Mayor and Aldermen believes it is in the best interest of the City to construct a temporary sidewalk; and

WHEREAS, the proposed temporary sidewalk will significantly improve pedestrian connectivity along the east side of Hillsboro Road; and

WHEREAS, the estimated cost to build a temporary sidewalk along Hillsboro Road is \$125,000, which will be appropriated through a forthcoming budget amendment; and

WHEREAS, the proposed NW Mack Hatcher Parkway Project is scheduled to start construction in the spring/summer of 2018 and will ultimately complete the pedestrian improvements along Hillsboro Road; and

WHEREAS, the entire temporary sidewalk will be removed and relocated as part of the NW Mack Hatcher Project; and

WHEREAS, it is estimated that a temporary sidewalk would benefit the City for 6 – 24 months prior to TDOT's contractor blocking pedestrian access, relocating utilities and widening the intersection of Mack Hatcher Parkway and Hillsboro Road.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF FRANKLIN, TENNESSEE, AS FOLLOWS: the Board of Mayor and Aldermen authorizes staff to proceed with the design, permitting, signal modification and construction of a temporary 5' wide sidewalk as conceptually shown on exhibit A. Funding for the temporary sidewalk will be appropriated by a future budget amendment.
