

**RESOLUTION 2018-53**

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING STAFF TO PROCEED WITH THE HOME RAISING PROJECT DEVELOPED BY THE UNITED STATES ARMY CORPS OF ENGINEERS AS PART OF THE HARPETH RIVER FEASIBILITY STUDY**

**WHEREAS**, on June 13, 2013, the United States Army Corps of Engineers (USACE), Metropolitan Nashville and Davidson County, City of Brentwood, and City of Franklin initiated and signed a Feasibility Study Agreement to analyze alternative flood risk management options with the Harpeth River basin; and

**WHEREAS**, on September 12, 2016, the City of Franklin entered into a second agreement with the USACE to fully develop one of the identified flood risk management projects; and

**WHEREAS**, the project generally includes the raisings of private homes ("Project"), and the USACE has determined that this Project is feasible and economically justifiable; and

**WHEREAS**, this Project would be a voluntary program for the homes identified by the USACE; and

**WHEREAS**, the USACE would contribute 65% of the funding associated with the Project, and they require a Non-Federal Sponsor to contribute the remaining 35% of the funding.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF FRANKLIN, TENNESSEE, AS FOLLOWS:** The Board of Mayor and Aldermen agree to participate in the Project as the Non-Federal Sponsor. The Non-Federal Sponsor's funding will be determined at a future date based on completion of the USACE review.
