

RESOLUTION NO. 2019-08

A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE PARK AT HARLINSDALE FARM MASTER PLAN AND PROVIDING RECOMMENDATIONS FOR IMPROVEMENTS AT THE PARK AT HARLINSDALE FARM.

WHEREAS, the Board of Mayor and Aldermen approved Resolution 2016-05, adopting the Comprehensive Parks and Recreation Master Plan; and

WHEREAS, the City of Franklin's 2015 Comprehensive Parks and Recreation Master Plan recommended specific improvements for The Park at Harlinsdale Farm including renovations to the Main Barn, Hayes House, North Barn, Worker Houses, and the design and construction of a Tennessee Walking Horse Museum; and

WHEREAS, the programming and facilities for The Park at Harlinsdale Farm were evaluated and documented in the Master Plan Summary Report, incorporating public input from community surveys, focus groups, and public meetings; and

WHEREAS, the City of Franklin desires to restore and preserve its historic sites; and

WHEREAS, the City of Franklin Parks Department, in partnership with Friends of Franklin Parks and the architecture and design firm Tuck-Hinton, developed a Master Plan for the improvements to The Park at Harlinsdale Farm; and

WHEREAS, the City understands that approval of The Park at Harlinsdale Farm Master Plan shall incorporate it into the existing conservation easement on the property.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF FRANKLIN, TENNESSEE, AS FOLLOWS:

1. That the City of Franklin approves the recommendation to accept The Park at Harlinsdale Farm Master Plan and incorporate it into the existing conservation easement.
2. That this resolution shall take effect from and after its adoption, the health, safety, and welfare of the Municipality requiring it.
