






















































# Process Moving Forward



#### **Process Moving Forward (Completed)**

#### September 2018

- BOMA provides top 3 non water/sewer projects to staff
- BOMA provides additional projects not included in CIP book to staff

#### October 2018

- Breakout Meetings with BOMA
  - Transportation Water/Sewer Parks & All Others
- At end of breakout meetings, BOMA will be asked to submit their top 10 prioritized rankings of all projects from each breakout meeting





#### **Process Moving Forward**

#### November 2018

- Staff will present BOMA consolidated prioritized rankings
- Staff will present formal review of Financial Model & discuss available funding

#### December 2018/January 2019

- Board Approval of FY 2019-2028 CIP Projects

#### **March 2019**

- City will issue G.O. Bonds to partially fund CIP projects

#### **May 2019**

City Administrator will present annual capital budget for FY 2020
