

RESOLUTION 2015-33

A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE SALE OF SURPLUS PROPERTY TO BI-COUNTY SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT AND TO AUTHORIZE THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO EXECUTE THE AGREEMENT FOR SUCH SALE

WHEREAS, the City of Franklin currently possesses a 2009 Kenworth T80 road tractor (“Vehicle”) for use in its Sanitation and Environmental Services Department; and

WHEREAS, the City no longer has use for the Vehicle and desires to declare it a surplus asset; and

WHEREAS, Bi-County Solid Waste Management, a solid waste authority created by interlocal agreement of Stewart and Montgomery Counties and pursuant to the laws of Tennessee (“Bi-County”), has requested to purchase the Vehicle for Fifty Thousand and No/100 Dollars (\$50,000.00); and

WHEREAS, Tennessee Code Annotated §12-2-420 provides that counties may purchase used or surplus personal property from a municipality upon approval by the governing bodies of both entities, without regard to any laws regarding public advertisement and competitive bidding; and

WHEREAS, Bi-County’s governing board approved the purchase on April 15, 2015; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Franklin, Tennessee find that it is in the best interests of the City to authorize the sale of the surplus Vehicle to Bi-County and to authorize the City Administrator to execute any documents necessary for such sale.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF FRANKLIN, TENNESSEE THAT:

Section 1. The Vehicle (2009 Kenworth T80, VIN 1XKDD40X19R250757) is hereby declared surplus property of the City and is authorized to be sold to Bi-County for Fifty Thousand and No/100 Dollars (\$50,000.00) pursuant to Tenn. Code Ann. §12-2-420.

Section 2. The City Administrator is hereby authorized to execute any contracts or other documents necessary to complete the sale.
