


Purpose of Department

The City of Franklin is governed by its elected officials, the Board of Mayor and Aldermen. The Board is comprised of the Mayor and eight Aldermen. Four aldermen are elected from the four political divisions of the City called wards; four are elected at-large. This governing board is responsible for deciding on the city's policies and procedures by passing Resolutions, Ordinances and the Municipal Code.

Base Budget Request:

The Board of Mayor and Aldermen includes the Mayor and eight aldermen: four serving at-large, and four serving as ward aldermen.

The budget is essentially level funded; though a large decrease is occurring in expenses as there is no election scheduled in FY 2017.
