DRAFT: This request is related to replacement of the existing equipment currently used for cleaning of sanitary sewer lines. The existing equipment is approximately 10 years old with close to 60,000 miles. The mileage is not indicative of the equipment usage. The hours of usage far exceed the time associated with travel as indicated by the mileage. Costs associated with maintenance over the last three years is approximately \$35,000. The equipment has had downtime which in some cases has impeded operations.								
	SERVICE IMPLICATI	ON						
DRAFT: This equipment is used to clean sanitary sewer infrastructure. The City uses two of this type of equipment to help maintain almost 400 miles of sanitary sewer lines. Downtime of this equipment could result in the inability to clear obstructed lines in the case of backups or overflows.
