ORDINANCE 2016-35

TO BE ENTITLED: "AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH A TEMPORARY ONE-HOUR PARKING TIME LIMIT ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF EAST MAIN STREET BETWEEN THE PUBLIC SQUARE AND 2^{ND} AVE SOUTH"

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the general health, welfare and safety of the public and the citizens of the City of Franklin that parking be regulated within the City; and

WHEREAS, parking is regulated pursuant to Title 15 of the Franklin Municipal Code, which provides that parking on the street is limited to four (4) hours; and

WHEREAS, the construction located at 231 Public Square required the closure of certain public property around the square and approximately 6 public on street parking spaces on the south side of E Main Street; and

WHEREAS, the business owner of Early's Honey Stand, fronting E. Main Street, between the Public Square and 2nd Ave has requested the City to establish a one-hour parking time Limit on the South Side of East Main Street between the Public Square and 2nd Ave South as shown in Exhibit A; and

WHEREAS, the one-hour time limit will help to improve temporary parking availability and parking turnover fronting these businesses during construction of 231 Public Square.

NOW THEREFORE:

ATTECT.

SECTION I: BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Franklin, Tennessee, that a one-hour parking limit be established on the south side of E. Main Street between the Public Square and 2nd Ave South during the construction of the 231 Public Square Project and shall revert back to the four (4) hour time limit when the public sidewalk and non-accessible on-street public parking spaces are again accessible to the general public.

SECTION II: BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Franklin, Tennessee, that the penalty for failure to obey the provisions of this Ordinance shall be as indicated in the Franklin Municipal Code and/or the Tennessee Code Annotated.

SECTION III: BE IT FINALLY ORDAINED by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Franklin, Tennessee, that this Ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage on second and final reading, the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Franklin requiring it.
