This request is to promote a Water Quality Specialist II (two) to a Water Quality Specialist III (Three) within the Engineering

As part of the City MS4 permit we are required to complete six minimum control measures that include the following: 1) Public Education and Outreach, 2) Public Involvement and Participation, 3) Illicit Discharge Detection and Elimination, 4) Construction Site Stormwater Runoff Control, 5) Permeant Stormwater Management in Development and Redevelopment and 6) Pollution Prevention for Municipal Operations. In addition we are required to do annual ambient monitoring that includes: 1) Macroinvertebrate Sampling, 2) E.Coli Sampling and 3) Visual Stream Assessments.

Staff has greatly underestimated the staffing needs related to control measure #4 Construction Site Stormwater Runoff Control and #5 Permeant Stormwater Management in Development and Redevelopment over the last several years. These two measure alone continue to consume 80-90% of ALL Stormwater Division positions time. This position will relieve the Stormwater Management Coordinator from having to oversee day to day operations of these two control measures and place this responsibility on the WQSIII. This will allow the Stormwater Management Coordinator to concentrate on management duties and overall Stormwater Program compliance and milestones achievements. Currently the City has applied for provisional Qualified Local Program (QLP) status. If approved, this position will manage the requirements associated with a QLP. This position will also complete the Water Quality Specialist I, II, and III series to be more in line with other departmental positions (Engineer I, II, and III)

This position will be responsible for the following within our Stormwater Management Program:

- \*Overseeing and managing the requirement of the QLP; Permitting, SWPPP review, data management and entry associated with QLP status (Monthly TDEC requirement)
- \*Overseeing control measure #4; Construction Site Stormwater Runoff Control permit requirements
- \*Review of development plans for compliance with control measure #5; Permeant Stormwater Management in Development and Redevelopment/Runoff Reduction; Green Infrastructure

#### **SERVICE IMPLICATION**

Without this employee we will not be in permit compliance with our NPDES permit. In addition we will not have adequate staffing to handle the Qualified Local Program requirements.

#### **PURPOSE / DESCRIPTION OF REQUEST**

This request is for a new Water Quality Specialist I (one) position within the Engineering Departments Stormwater Division

As part of the City MS4 permit we are required to complete six minimum control measures that include the following: 1) Public Education and Outreach, 2) Public Involvement and Participation, 3) Illicit Discharge Detection and Elimination, 4) Construction Site Stormwater Runoff Control, 5) Permeant Stormwater Management in Development and Redevelopment and 6) Pollution Prevention for Municipal Operations. In addition we are required to do annual ambient monitoring that includes: 1) Macroinvertebrate Sampling, 2) E.Coli Sampling and 3) Visual Stream Assessments.

In Department Priority number 1 we have asked to promote a WQSII (two) to a WQSIII (three). We wish to leave the WQSII (two) position vacant for the time being to allow growth within the current WQSI (one) employees for future promotional opportunities. The WQSII (two) positions written intent, is to design and conduct ambient monitoring requirements and post-construction BMP maintenance compliance. Currently this employee spends 80-90% of their time conducting construction site inspections which is inconsistent with the job description. We would like to backfill the WQSII (two) position (and associated work load of construction site inspections) with a WQSI (one) position in order to have personnel performing job duties consistent with their job description.

The design and conducting of ambient monitoring requirements and post-construction BMP maintenance compliance will be distributed between the WQSI (one), WQSIII (three) and Stormwater Management Coordinator indefinitely until the right promotional potentials come along for the current WQSI (one).

#### **SERVICE IMPLICATION**

Without this employee we will not be in permit compliance with our NPDES permit. In addition we will not have adequate staffing to handle the Qualified Local Program requirements.
