WHEREAS, the efficiency of the qualified and dedicated personnel who staff public works departments is influenced by their attitude and understanding of the importance of the work they perform; and


WHEREAS, the year 2017 marks the 57th annual National Public Works Week sponsored by the American Public Works Association;
