

RESOLUTION NO. 2017-46

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF FRANKLIN TO ENTER AN AGREEMENT WITH WILLIAMSON COUNTY SCHOOLS TO SHARE THE COST OF EXTENDING SANITARY SEWER SERVICES TO BOTH THE OAKVIEW ELEMENTARY SCHOOL AND THE FUTURE MIDDLE SCHOOL ON HENPECK LANE

WHEREAS, the Oak View Elementary School, located on Henpeck Lane, was constructed in 1993; and

WHEREAS, the Oak View School is located just outside of the Franklin's city limits and is served by a small onsite sanitary sewer system or "package plant"; and

WHEREAS, the Williamson County Schools owns approximately 35 acres of land, adjacent to the Oak View School, that has been identified as a potential site for a new middle school (grades 6th through 8th); and

WHEREAS, Williamson County School System desires to have the Oak View Elementary and the future middle school to be served by the City of Franklin sanitary sewer systems; and

WHEREAS, the estimated cost for the extension of the sanitary sewer line is \$2.36 million (\$2.1 million for construction, \$260,000 for design and land costs); and

WHEREAS, the impacted, county-owned property will be annexed into the City of Franklin prior to the completion of the project; and

WHEREAS, Williamson County Schools has agreed to provide the City with easements needed to extend sanitary sewer to other undeveloped property within the area; and

WHEREAS, the City's portion of the project expense (\$1.18 million) would come from the City's County Facilities Tax fund, consistent with prior practices and fund purpose.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF FRANKLIN, TENNESSEE, AS FOLLOWS:

1. Williamson County Schools and the City of Franklin will share equally the full costs of the project; and
2. The sanitary sewer extension project will be a City of Franklin project to facilitate design and property acquisition necessary for its timely completion; and
3. The City's portion will come from the City's County Facilities Tax; and
4. This resolution shall take effect from and after its adoption, the welfare of the Municipality requiring it.
