## **RESOLUTION 2017-41**

## A RESOLUTION ADOPTING A REVISED PURCHASING POLICY FOR CITY OF FRANKLIN, TENNESSEE PROCUREMENTS NOT PERTAINING TO THE DESIGN AND/OR CONSTRUCTION OF NEW INFRASTRUCTURE AND FACILITIES

WHEREAS, in 2004, the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Franklin established methods to comply with the Municipal Purchasing Law of 1983, as amended, and to provide for a more formal process for the procurement of equipment, services, and materials for the operation of municipal government but not pertaining to the design and/or construction of new infrastructure and facilities; and

**WHEREAS**, on July 26, 2011, the Board of Mayor and Aldermen adopted Resolution No. 2011-26, a resolution adopting a revised purchasing policy for the City; and

**WHEREAS**, on January 14, 2014, the Board of Mayor and Aldermen adopted Resolution No. 2014-06, a resolution adopting a revised purchasing policy for the City; and

**WHEREAS**, on January 27, 2015, the Board of Mayor and Aldermen adopted Resolution No. 2014-90, a resolution adopting a revised purchasing policy for the City; and

**WHEREAS**, on June 28, 2016, the Board of Mayor and Aldermen adopted Resolution No. 2016-24, a resolution adopting a revised purchasing policy for the City; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Mayor and Aldermen believes it is in the best interest of the City of Franklin for the purchasing policy to be further revised to reference federal regulation pertaining to procurement of property and/or services under a federal award; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Mayor and Aldermen believes it is in the best interest of the City of Franklin for the purchasing policy to be further revised to indicate how requests to inspect and/or obtain either complete or partial copies of purchasing-related records are to be handled; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Mayor and Aldermen believes it is in the best interest of the City of Franklin to implement a revised Purchasing Policy for procurements not pertaining to the design and/or construction of new infrastructure and facilities in order to reflect these changes and to otherwise update the City's policy.

## NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF FRANKLIN, TENNESSEE, AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1.</u> The purchasing policy for City of Franklin procurements not pertaining to new construction adopted by Resolution No. 2016-24, and any and all subsequent changes or revisions, are hereby repealed in their entirety. In place thereof, the purchasing policy for City of Franklin procurements not pertaining to the design and/or construction of new infrastructure and facilities, attached as Exhibit A hereto, is adopted.

<u>Section 2.</u> The Purchasing Manager of the City shall be responsible for the administration and enforcement of the policy hereby adopted.

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<u>Section 3.</u> Changes or revisions to the policy hereby adopted shall be made only by resolution of the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Franklin.

<u>Section 4.</u> The effective date of the policy hereby adopted shall be immediate upon passage and adoption of this resolution, the public welfare and the welfare of the City requiring it.
