Current Weekly Curbside Residential Services

- Residential municipal solid waste (MSW) collection
- Blue bag recycling
- Brush collection
- Yard waste (brown bags)
- Ground trash (buck-a-bag)
- Bulky waste



Core Services

- Maintain our weekly MSW and recycling collection
- Continue to evaluate the use of rollout carts for recycling
 - Safety
 - Efficiency
 - Marshall County's ability to process volume due to handling of bags
 - Recycling commodity market



Brush and Brown Bag Collection

- Combine brush and brown bag collection
 - Combining these services would eliminate three trucks from routes on a daily basis
 - Will reduce labor requirements and injuries
 - Reduce number of temporary staff



Ground Trash and Bulky Waste

- Ground trash
 - Reevaluate buck-a-bag program and other alternatives
 - Current revenues indicate that ground trash far exceeds use of buck-a-bag stickers
- Bulky waste
 - Move towards a more focused bulky waste collection model using call-in scheduling



Route Smart Enabled Tablet Key Benefits

- Program enhancement (priority 1) (~\$145,000)
- Provides visual and voice navigation
- Improve driver training on new routes
- Web based live view of truck locations for customer service staff and management showing locations serviced
- Drivers will be able to input real time issues at collection points such as cart not out, cart blocked, cart needs repair, trash on ground
- If a truck breaks down during a route, another driver can navigate to the unfinished route and finish the route
- Fundamental component for being able to efficiently route call in service request
- Export reports and data for management review
