

RESOLUTION NO. 2018-27

A RESOLUTION TO FUND AND AUTHORIZE STAFF TO PROCEED WITH THE DESIGN, RIGHT-OF-WAY ACQUISITION, AND CONSTRUCTION PHASE FOR THE WEST MAIN STREET BRIDGE MODIFICATIONS PROJECT (LOCATED JUST NORTHEAST OF ROBERTS STREET).

WHEREAS, the existing bridge located on West Main Street is approximately 26' wide; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Mayor and Aldermen desire to widen this bridge, to improve the safety of the roadway, by adding a shoulder on the north side of the bridge; and

WHEREAS, the City of Franklin Engineering Department has presented the design option and cost estimate as shown in Exhibit A to the Board of Mayor and Aldermen.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF FRANKLIN, TENNESSEE, that staff is directed to proceed with the design, right-of-way acquisition, and construction of the conceptual project as shown in exhibit A. Funding for the project shall be either amended into the FY 2018-2019 Engineering Stormwater Capital Budget or included in the FY 2019-2020 Engineering Stormwater Capital Budget.
