ORDINANCE 2018-08

TO BE ENTITLED: "AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE 2013-50, ATMOS ENERGY CORPORATION FRANCHISE AGREEMENT TO EXTEND THE TERM FOR AN ADDITIONAL TEN (10) YEARS."

WHEREAS, on October 8, 2013, the City of Franklin and Atmos Energy entered into a Franchise Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the Agreement set forth a term limit of five (5) years; and

WHEREAS, that term expires at the end of November 2018; and

WHEREAS, the parties agree to an extension of the agreement; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Mayor and Aldermen believe an extension to be in the best interest of the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF FRANKLIN, TENNESSEE, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: That Section 4 of the 2013-50 Ordinance Granting a Franchise Agreement to Atmos shall be amended to read as follows:

<u>Term.</u> This Franchise and the rights herein granted shall take effect and be enforced from and after the Effective Date hereof, and shall continue in force for ten (10) years from and after the date of the passage of this Ordinance.

SECTION 2: BE IT FINALLY ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF FRANKLIN, TENNESSEE, that this Ordinance shall take effect on from and after its passage on Final Reading by the City, and upon approval of the Tennessee Public Utility Commission; the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Franklin requiring it.
