This letter hereby serves as a non-binding letter of intent of the City's conditional acceptance of a partial portion of the remaining inventory, as set forth in the Donation Agreement, COF Contract No. 2018-0152. More specifically, of the remaining inventory referenced in the Donation Agreement, the City agrees to accept and pick up (43) light bars and (20) partitions on Monday, July 2, 2018.

The parties understand and agree that this delivery and acceptance is conditioned upon the Board of Mayor and Alderman's final approval, anticipated to occur on July 10, 2018, of the Donation Agreement and all of the specified remaining inventory, as detailed in the proposed Donation Agreement.

Both parties understand and agree that if the Board of Mayor and Alderman deny the approval of the proposed Donation Agreement, then the partial portion of inventory – the light bars and partitions – must be returned immediately to Donor at the above address.
