

ORDINANCE 2018-31

TO BE ENTITLED: "AN ORDINANCE TO REAPPOINT DEANA HOOD AS CITY JUDGE FOR THE CITY COURT OF FRANKLIN, TENNESSEE."

WHEREAS, Article X of the City of Franklin Charter provides for a City Court and a City Judge and that the term and compensation of the City Judge are to be provided by ordinance; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ordinance 2014-34, the City appointed Deana Hood to the City Judge position on October 28, 2014 for a term of four (4) years; and

WHEREAS, the term will expire October 28, 2018; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Mayor and Aldermen believe it is in the best interest of the citizens of the City of Franklin to reappoint Deana Hood based on her performance over the past four (4) years to the position of City Judge for a term of four (4) years.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Franklin, Tennessee that Deana Hood is hereby reappointed Judge of the Municipal Court of the City of Franklin, Tennessee at a salary of \$25,000.00 per year.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Franklin, Tennessee, that Deana Hood shall serve as Judge of the Municipal Court of the City of Franklin for a term of four (4) years. She may be removed by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen for cause during that term. In the event that the position is vacated during the term, the vacancy shall be filled by an application and interview process.

BE IT FINALLY ORDAINED by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Franklin, Tennessee that this Ordinance shall take effect October 28, 2018, the public health, safety, and welfare requiring it.
