ORDINANCE 2018-39

AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH ALL-WAY STOP CONTROL AT THE INTERSECTION OF 1ST AVENUE SOUTH AND CHURCH STREET.

WHEREAS, the intersection of 1st Avenue South and Church Street is currently configured with stop control on the Church Street approach only; and

WHEREAS, the sight distance from Church Street onto 1st Avenue South does not meet the minimum requirements as published in both the City of Franklin *Transportation & Street Technical Standards, 2017 Edition* ("Franklin Street Specs") and the American Association of State Highway and Transportation Officials' A Policy on Geometric Design of Highways and Streets, 6th Edition, 2011 ("Green Book"); and

WHEREAS, the Federal Highway Administration's *Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices for Streets and Highways* ("MUTCD") allows the application of all-way stop control at intersections with limited sight distance that create a safety concern.

NOW THEREFORE:

SECTION I: BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Franklin, Tennessee, that all-way stop control is hereby established at the intersection of 1st Avenue South and Church Street.

SECTION II: BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the Director of Streets is hereby authorized and directed to install stop signs at said location and as shown in Exhibit A to regulate traffic approaching this intersection.

SECTION III: BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Franklin, Tennessee, that the penalty for failure to obey the provisions of this Ordinance shall be as indicated in the Franklin Municipal Code and/or the Tennessee Code Annotated.

SEECTION IV: BE IT FINALLY ORDAINED by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Franklin, Tennessee, that this Ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage on second and final reading, the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Franklin requiring it.
