BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF FRANKLIN, TENNESSEE, that the City Administrator is hereby authorized to have authority to review and approve the spending of all project funds included in the bid and award of the construction contract for the Fire Station 7 (COF Contract No. 2018-0259).
