- October 2018: At the end of each breakout meeting, BOMA will be asked to submit their top 10 prioritized rankings of all projects from each meeting. Spreadsheets were provided to the Board to rank their Top 10 Transportation projects.
- November 2018: Staff will present BOMA consolidated prioritized rankings, present a formal review of Financial Model, and discuss available funding.
- December 2018/January 2019: Board approval of FY 2019-2028 CIP Projects.
- March 2019: City will issue G.O. Bonds to partially fund CIP projects.
- May 2019: City Administrator will present annual capital budget for FY 2020.

Ward Aldermen, most critical projects in their Wards:

- Ward 1 Alderman Burger: McEwen and I-65; Oxford Glen multiuse trail; Jordan Road.
- Ward 2 Alderman McLendon: Carlisle Lane; Franklin Road and Mallory Station.
- Ward 3 Alderman Speedy: Long Lane connector; Carothers North.
- Ward 4 Vice Mayor Martin: Lewisburg Avenue sidewalk to Carriage Park through Collins Farm; Infrastructure on South Margin Street; Repair broken pavement on Main Street.
- Project ST 16020 Highway 96 trail system, \$1.8 million federal funds for construction will be lost. \$5.2 million project overall. Critical timing with grant money.
