A RESOLUTION RECOMMENDING APPROVAL OF THE MIDNIGHT SUN SCAVENGER HUNT PUBLIC ART INSTALLATION

WHEREAS, the Williamson County Convention and Visitors Bureau created the Midnight Sun Scavenger Hunt to encourage visitors and residents to explore the City of Franklin; and

WHEREAS, the Scavenger Hunt includes the installation of ten miniature bronze horse statues at different historical locations throughout Franklin; and

WHEREAS, the locations are: Visitor Center, McPhail-Cliffe Office, The Green House, The Factory, St. Paul's Episcopal Church, the Carter House, Dan German Hospital, Landmark Booksellers, Shuff's Music, and the Park at Harlinsdale Farm; and

WHEREAS, the City of Franklin Parks Department worked with the Convention and Visitors Bureau on this project and has given approval for the statue that will be located at the Park at Harlinsdale Farm; and

WHEREAS, the Historic Zoning Commission has reviewed the project and is recommending approval of the installations; and

WHEREAS, the Franklin Public Arts Commission was established to review and make recommendations concerning all aspects of public art and is recommending approval of the installations.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF FRANKLIN, TENNESSEE, that:

- **Section 1.** Based on the recommendations for approval by the Historic Zoning Commission and the Franklin Public Arts Commission, the Midnight Sun Scavenger Hunt public art installation project is hereby approved.
- **Section 2.** The installations of the miniature statues at the privately-owned locations shall be the responsibility of the Williamson County Convention and Visitors Bureau and the installation of the miniature statue at the Park at Harlinsdale Farm shall be the responsibility of the City of Franklin.
- **Section 3.** The miniature statutes shall be drilled into cement or wood at each location with bolts that will readily attach to their granite bases.
- **Section 4.** The Williamson County Convention and Visitors Bureau shall be fully responsible for the maintenance of all of the miniature statues.
 - **Section 5.** None of the miniature statues shall be placed in any public right-of-way.
