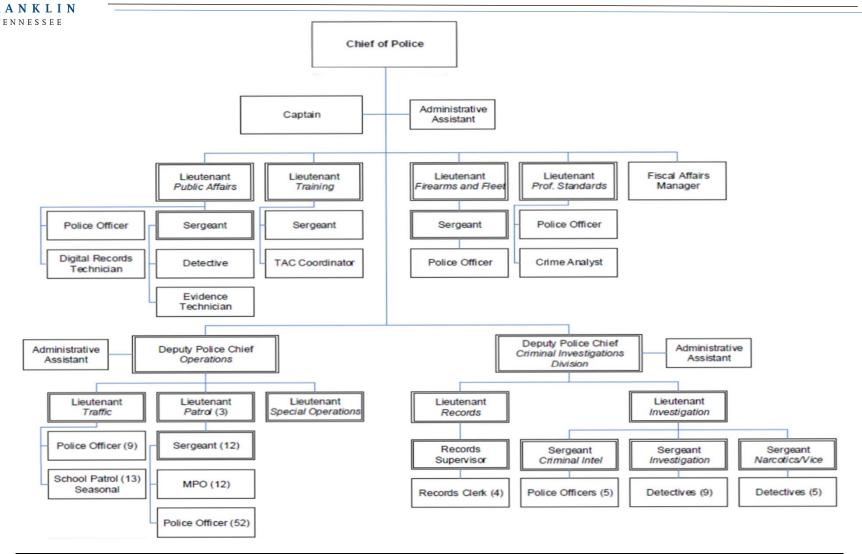


#### **Purpose of Department**

<u>Our Mission:</u> To provide professional police services, in partnership with the community, to ensure a safer Franklin and enhance the quality of life.

The Franklin Police Department is responsible for: protecting the public from crime; investigating and apprehending lawbreakers; enforcing City ordinances and traffic laws; providing traffic control at the street level and at City schools; and, providing crime prevention information to various groups throughout the community.

- Proposed level-service budget for Personnel is \$12,627,159
- The anticipated overage in 2019 can mostly be attributed to increased overtime spending

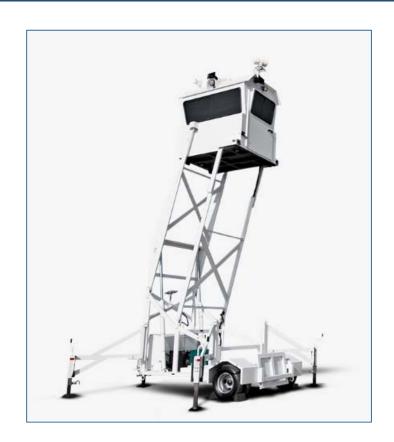

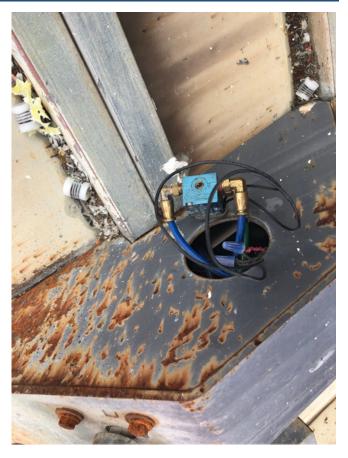






#### **Program Enhancement #11 – Century Court Firing Range**







#### **Long Term Needs**

#### Personnel

- Add a total of 16 sworn positions by FY 2022
- Estimated cost: \$98,000 per officer, per year for salaries, benefits, equipment and operating costs

#### Vehicles

- Annual replacement of vehicles at the end of service life
- Estimated cost: \$1.5 million annually

#### Century Court Range

- Long term solution may be the creation of an indoor range or retrofitting the existing range
- Estimated cost: \$750,000 \$1.5 million +

#### **Purpose of Department**

The Drug Fund is really a special revenue account established under Tennessee Code Annotated (T.C.A.) 39-17-420.

Revenues come from one-half of the fines from drug offenses, any cash that is forfeited to the city or county as well as the proceeds from the sale of any forfeited property (usually vehicles) and donations.

Legitimate expenditures for the fund include: drug treatment programs, drug education, drug enforcement expenditures, drug identification kits for drug investigators and patrol, drug enforcement training, drug dogs and their maintenance, and confidential expenditures.

Major reason for decrease: Several additional one-time expenditures were made in FY 2019. These are not planned in FY 2020.
