(Westfield Estates and Idlewood)

Oxford Drive & Piedmont Circle <i>(104 Oxford Drive)</i>	August 22 – 24, 2018	335	28 MPH
Oxford Drive & Patrick Avenue <i>(203 Oxford Drive)</i>	August 28 – 31, 2018	155	26 MPH

NOTE: RED volumes and speeds did not meet criteria for traffic calming, while GREEN numbers did meet the criteria.

Criteria to Participate in the City of Franklin Neighborhood Traffic Calming Program (NTCP):

- Average Daily Traffic (ADT) volume is ≥ 500 vehicles per day
- 85TH Percentile Speed is ≥ 7 MPH *faster* than the posted speed limit
- Posted Speed Limit is 35 MPH *or less*
- Street is a Through Street
- Maximum Grade of Street $\leq 8\%$
- Adequate Site Distance for Traffic Calming Measures
- Street is *NOT* a transit route or primary emergency access route.
