Features such as taper lengths, horizontal and vertical geometry, clear zones, guardrail requirements, etc., shall be evaluated In greater detail at the site plan stage and will be required to conform to the accepted standard in order to ensure public safety and well-being, as well as the continued functionality of the existing and proposed street networks. The first access on Aspen Grove Drive shall require additional analysis at site plan. The applicant shall provide the trip distribution for the known uses at Site Plan. This will allow Staff to make a recommendation regarding the safety of a westbound left turning movement at this location.
