A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PRE-ORDERING OF EOUIPMENT PRIOR TO THE COMMENCEMENT OF THE NEW FISCAL YEAR

WHEREAS, the City of Franklin desires to maintain an efficient and cost-effective fleet for all of its operations; and

WHEREAS, the Sanitation and Environmental Services Fund has several pieces of equipment which have reached the end of their useful life and need to be replaced; and

WHEREAS, the lead time in ordering, assembling and delivering these pieces of equipment can take the majority of a fiscal year, resulting in the continued use, maintenance and incurred expense of older equipment.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen for the City of Franklin as follows:

Section 1. The Board of Mayor and Aldermen authorizes the City Administrator to preorder these necessary replacement pieces of equipment prior to the start of the new Fiscal Year. This authorization extends only to the pre-ordering of Sanitation & Environmental Services equipment. Section 2. The Board of Mayor and Aldermen desire to pay for the purchase of these pieces of equipment in the following (FY 2020) operating budget of the Sanitation and Environmental Services Fund. Section 3. The Board of Mayor and Aldermen understand that these pieces of equipment will not be acquired until the year in which resources have been appropriated for their purchase (FY 2020). Section 4.
