A RESOLUTION TO RESCIND RESOLUTION 2019-55, A RESOLUTION AWARDING THE THIRD-PARTY ADMINISTRATOR CONTRACT FOR THE CITY'S WORKERS COMPENSATION PROGRAM TO PMA COMPANIES IN THE AMOUNT OF \$73,978, BEGINNING WITH THE POLICY YEAR BEGINNING JULY 1, 2019 AND FOR A TERM OF AWARD, FOR THE RISK MANAGEMENT DIVISION OF THE HUMAN RESOURCES DEPARTMENT, AND REJECTING ALL BIDS FOR SAID PROCUREMENT (PURCHASING OFFICE PROCUREMENT SOLICITATION NO. 2019-011; CONTRACT NO. 2019-0160)

WHEREAS, the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Franklin, Tennessee, desires to move toward the most effective administration of City business; and

WHEREAS, on March 7, 2019, the City of Franklin published a Request for Proposals for Third-Party Workers' Compensation Claims Administration (Purchasing Office Procurement Solicitation No. 2019-11); and

WHEREAS, City Staff recommended the award of the contract (COF Contract No. 2019-0160) for Third Party Administrative services to PMA Companies in the amount of \$73,978.00; and

WHEREAS, on May 28, 2019, the Board of Mayor and Aldermen adopted Resolution 2019-55, granting approval to the City Administrator and City Attorney to finalize the contract documents with PMA Companies, and granting authority to the City Administrator to execute the said contract; and

WHEREAS, Resolution 2019-55 specified that it did not guarantee the award of the said contract to PMA Companies, and that no agreement was final until executed; and

WHEREAS, upon further review an irregularity in the bid process was found by City Staff; and

WHEREAS, after careful consideration, City Staff recommends rejecting all bids associated with Purchasing Office Procurement Solicitation No. 2019-11 and rebidding the services; and

WHEREAS, City Staff further recommends rescission of Resolution 2019-55, which arose from Purchasing Office Procurement Solicitation No. 2019-11.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Franklin, Tennessee, that based on the recitals set forth above all bids associated with Purchasing Office Procurement Solicitation No. 2019-11 are rejected and Resolution 2019-55, related thereto, is hereby rescinded.
