## **ORDINANCE 2019-26**

## AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH A FOUR (4) HOUR TIME LIMIT FOR ALL PUBLIC PARKING SPACES LOCATED ON WEST MAIN STREET BETWEEN 5TH AVENUE AND 7TH AVENUE.

WHEREAS, the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Franklin, Tennessee, approved, on second and final reading on July 10, 2018, Ordinance 2018-27, as amended, to implement time restricted parking within the core commercial/retail historic downtown area; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance 2018-27, established a two (2) hour time limit for public parking in much of the downtown area, including along West Main Street between 5th Avenue and 7th Avenue; and

WHEREAS, at the Capital Investment Committee meeting on June 27, 2019, Alderman Martin, at the request of local business owners, directed staff to draft an ordinance to return the time limit for public parking on West Main Street, between 6th Avenue and 7th Avenue, to four (4) hours; and

WHEREAS, the angle parking along the south side of West Main Street is arranged in such a manner that prevents the simple establishment of a single time restriction for public parking on West Main Street between 6th Avenue and 7th Avenue only; and

**WHEREAS,** for ease of use by the public and for enforcement by the City, staff recommends that all public parking spaces on West Main Street, between 5th Avenue and 7th Avenue, be signed with the same time restriction.

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF FRANKLIN, TENNESSEE, AS FOLLOWS:

**SECTION I.** That a four (4) hour time limit be established for all public parking spaces located on West Main Street between 5th Avenue and 7th Avenue.

**SECTION II.** That the Director of the Streets Department is hereby authorized and directed to install proper signage to inform the public of the new parking time limit.

**SECTION III.** That the penalty for failure to obey the provisions of this Ordinance shall be as indicated in the Franklin Municipal Code and/or the Tennessee Code Annotated.

**SECTION IV.** BE IT FINALLY ORDAINED by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Franklin, Tennessee, that this Ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage on second and final reading.
