## A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE STATE OF TENNESSEE NAME THE BRIDGE AT THE NORTHWEST MACK HATCHER EXTENSION THE CHARLES M. SARGENT JR. MEMORIAL BRIDGE

**WHEREAS**, Charles M. Sargent Jr., a native New Yorker, moved to Tennessee in 1970 and made his home in Franklin in 1977; and

**WHEREAS,** Charles Sargent dedicated his life to the service of his community, his state, and his country; and

WHEREAS, Charles Sargent served his nation in the U.S. Navy; and

**WHEREAS**, Charles Sargent became a Williamson County Commissioner in 1990, where he went on to serve as Budget Committee Chair and Regional Planning Commission Chair; and

**WHEREAS**, Charles Sargent was the 61<sup>st</sup> State Representative from January 1997 until his passing in 2018; and

WHEREAS, Charles Sargent, as State Representative, provided vital leadership to the State of Tennessee as Chair of the House Finance, Ways, and Means Committee and championed the cause of public education, including the expansion of Columbia State Community College; and

**WHEREAS**, Charles Sargent, first as a County Commissioner and later as a State Representative, advocated for State of Tennessee investment in transportation improvements, including the extension of the Mack Hatcher Parkway in northwest Franklin.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF FRANKLIN, TENNESSEE, THAT:

The City of Franklin supports a request to the State of Tennessee to name the bridge at the Northwest Mack Hatcher Extension the *Charles M. Sargent Jr. Memorial Bridge*.
