The City of Franklin is in the process of updating the Zoning Ordinance and Zoning Map. You are receiving this notice letter because a property you own on Fairground Street in the City of Franklin is currently proposed to be rezoned as a part of the Zoning Ordinance update to better align with the City's Long-Range Plan, Envision Franklin.

Your property is currently zoned Heavy Industrial (HI) and is proposed to change to Mixed Residential (MR), which allows for a mix of residential uses including single family homes, duplexes, townhouses, and multiplexes (up to four units per structure).
