ORDINANCE 2019-55

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND TITLE 15, CHAPTER 6, SECTION 15-603 OF THE FRANKLIN MUNICIPAL CODE, PERTAINING TO STOPPING, STANDING, OR PARKING NEAR MAILBOXES

WHEREAS, The City of Franklin is committed to providing access to government services such as the United States Postal Services; and

WHEREAS, the public receives important mail through deliveries from postal services; and

WHEREAS, the United States Postal Service is responsible for providing postal service in the United States, including its insular areas and associate states; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Mayor and Aldermen believes this amendment is in the best interest of the City of Franklin.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF FRANKLIN BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I. That Title 15, Chapter 6, Section 15-603 of the Franklin Municipal Code is hereby amended to add the following subsection (i) to subparagraph (2) as follows:

Sec. 15-603. - Stopping, standing or parking—Prohibited locations:

- (2) No person shall stop, stand or park a vehicle, except momentarily to pick up or discharge a passenger or passengers:
 - (i) Within 15 feet of a mailbox.

SECTION II. BE IT FINALLY ORDAINED by the Board of Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Franklin, Tennessee, that this Ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage on third and final reading, the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens requiring it.
