RESOLUTION NO. 2020-04

A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE PLANNING DEPARTMENT, IN COOPERATION WITH THE PARKS DEPARTMENT, ON BEHALF OF THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN, TO SUBMIT TWO APPLICATIONS TO THE STATE HISTORIC PRESERVATION OFFICE FOR HISTORIC PRESERVATION FUNDS GRANTS TO BE USED AT CITY CEMETERY AND THE HISTORIC HAYES HOME

WHEREAS, the State Historic Preservation Office is accepting grant applications for historic preservation projects; and

WHEREAS, the City of Franklin currently maintains the historic properties known as City Cemetery and The Park at Harlinsdale Farm where the Historic Hayes Home is located; and

WHEREAS, the ironwork in City Cemetery is in disrepair and requires restoration to avoid total loss; and

WHEREAS, in 2019 the Parks Department began restoration work on the Historic Hayes Home's windows and wishes to continue restoration work on the home's exterior windows and interior transoms; and

WHEREAS, these restoration projects will enable the Parks Department to better maintain these historic properties; and

WHEREAS, the estimated cost for the ironwork at City Cemetery is approximately Nine Thousand Dollars (\$9,000) and the estimated cost for the window restoration at the Historic Hayes Home is approximately Twenty-Four Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$24,500); and

WHEREAS, the historic preservation grants are a 60/40 matching grant with sixty percent (60%) coming from the State and forty percent (40%) coming from the City, making the City's total obligation to the City Cemetery project Three Thousand Six Hundred Dollars (\$3,600) and the obligation to the Historic Hayes Home window restoration project is Nine Thousand Eight Hundred Dollars (\$9,800).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF FRANKLIN, TENNESSEE, AS FOLLOWS:

The City Administrator is hereby authorized to sign and submit applications for two (2) historic preservation grants to be matched by the City up to forty percent (40%) of the total cost of each project.
