This would promote our current TOC Operator to the position of ITS Specialist. The ITS Specialist assists with inspection and configuration of traffic and ITS devices, including wiring, software configuration, setup and data management from our ITS and traffic signal devices. This position assists the Streets Department in the procurment, construction and inspection of traffic signal equipment and is solely responsible for ITS equipment procurement, construction, configuration and maintenance (such as the CCTV cameras).

SERVICE IMPLICATION

Our current TOC Operator (Abby Gambill) has been training for and performing many of the duties of the ITS Specialist. With anticipation of the promotion of our ITS Specialist to Project Manager, the ITS Specialist position will need to be filled so that our ITS devices can be maintained and configured accordingly to our TOC standards. Without this position, our devices, including knowledgebase of configuration and maintenance of the devices, will be severly diminished. Downtime could be extended should an incident occur with our devices if this position is not filled.

PURPOSE / DESCRIPTION OF REQUEST

This data service enables the City to pull various traffic data to assist in analyzing development and growth in and around the City of Franklin. The data service provides origin/destination, travel time, speed as well as many socio-economic factors associated with the data. Pedestrian studies are also available with this service.

SERVICE IMPLICATION

Prior to this service, individual traffic data studies (such as origin/destination studies, speed studies and travel time studies) of corridors had to be requested which can be very costly due to devices and/or manpower to perform each study. This "Big Data" service reduces study costs and allows us to study multiple corridors and areas at one time at a fraction of the cost. For example, one such service it can provide is taking a neighborhood, such as Westhaven, and produce data showing how vehicles from that neighborhood are getting to I-65 -- which routes the vehicles are taking and how much time it is taking by various times of the day. It can also show us how people are getting into downtown Franklin, which routes they are chosing, etc so we can plan roadways, parking lot locations and the like accordingly.

Neighborhood traffic calming requests have increased in the past 2 years. Perceived/Increased cut-through traffic and/or speeding has increased these types of requests from Franklin citizens. Engineering has increased their work load to perform many additional speed and count studies requested by citizens and management, as well as additional budget to purchase the traffic devices when a petition and study are successful.
