## A RESOLUTION AWARDING THE CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT (COF 2020-0005) FOR WATSON BRANCH CULVERT REHABILITATION TO CHASE RELINE, INC., IN THE AMOUNT OF \$539,266.00 AND ESTABLISHING A PROJECT CONTINGENCY OF \$100,000.00.

WHEREAS, On August 13, 2019, the Board of Mayor and Aldermen approved Resolution 2019-68, "A Resolution To Adopt The Project List For The FY 2019-2028 CIP (Capital Investment Program)"; and

WHEREAS, The Watson Branch Culvert Rehabilitation Project was included on the CIP project list in the amount of \$530,000; and

WHEREAS, On February 20<sup>th</sup>, 2020, sealed bids were received by the City of Franklin Engineering Department, 109 Third Avenue South, Franklin, Tennessee, 37064, and was publicly opened and read aloud for the Watson Branch culvert rehabilitation project (COF 2020-0005); and

**WHEREAS,** After careful review and tabulation of submitted bid, City staff recommends awarding the construction contract (COF 2020-0005) to Chase Reline, Inc. in the amount of (\$539,266.00).

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF FRANKLIN, TENNESSEE, AS FOLLOWS:

**SECTION I.** Approval is granted to award the construction contract (COF 2020-0005) to Chase Reline, Inc., for the Watson Branch Culvert Rehabilitation Project in the amount of (\$539,266.00)

**SECTION II.** Approval is granted to create a project contingency in the amount of (\$100,000) for the Watson Branch Rehabilitation Project.

**SECTION III.** Authority is granted to the City Administrator, City Engineer, and the Assistant Director of Engineering to review and approve the spending of all project funds, both in the bid award and from the project contingency, toward the completion of the Watson Branch Culvert Rehabilitation Project.
