### **Background**

Kimley-Horn and Associates, Inc. was hired to assist the City with the submittal of the 2017 Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality (CMAQ) Grant Application. The grant application was for the retiming of thirteen (13) traffic signals located along Murfreesboro Road (SR-96) between Eddy Lane and Arno Road.

### **Financial Impact**

\$4,500 paid out of the engineering departments annual budget.
