Purpose

The purpose of this memorandum is to provide information to the Franklin Board of Mayor and Aldermen (BOMA) concerning Resolution 2018-32.

Background

The City has been awarded \$1,800,000 in federal Transportation Alternative Program (TAP) funds to help pay for the construction of a multi-use trail along the north side of SR-96 West between Vera Valley Drive and 5TH Avenue North. The design plans are nearing completion, and staff would like to begin the acquisition of right-of-way and easements as soon as possible. This resolution authorizes staff to initiate condemnation should the property acquisition / negotiations fail.
