### **Purpose**

The purpose of this memorandum is to present to the Franklin Board of Mayor and Aldermen (BOMA) information to request the purchase of two license plate readers for the Franklin Police Department.

### **Background**

The license plate readers will be used as an investigative tool. This equipment will be placed throughout the city and will allow the police department to obtain information to help solve crimes, find stolen vehicles, and capture suspicious activity.

### **Financial Impact**

There is no upfront cost for the license plate readers. However, there will be a reoccurring usage fee cost of \$2,000.00 dollars per year per license plate reader. This cost will be paid from the Drug Fund.

### **Recommendation**

The City Administrator approved the agreement for and acquisition of two license plate readers under authority granted by the BOMA.
